

Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The Comal County Emergency Services District #2 conducted public hearings on September 10, 2009 and September 17, 2009 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Comal County Emergency Services District #2 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 128.72 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.020000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$508,672.38.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.045000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$1,157,438.53.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.045000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$1,205,474.61.

The Board of Director's is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 24, 2009 at the Fire/EMS Building, 1425 Sattler Road , Sattler, TX 78133 at 6:30 P.M.
